Dr. Pagnoux trained and graduated in internal medicine and clinical immunology in Paris, France.

He was appointed in 2002 as assistant professor, and worked in the division directed by his long-time mentor Prof. Loic Guillevin, who created the French Vasculitis Study Group (FVSG). He has served as vice-president of this latter research group and has been involved in several therapeutic trials and cohort studies in vasculitis conducted by FVSG in France or by the European Vasculitis Study Group.

Dr. Pagnoux moved to Canada was appointed in 2012 in the Division of Rheumatology at Mount Sinai Hospital, Toronto. He joined the steering committee of the North-American Vasculitis Clinical Research Consortium (VCRC), and founded CanVasc, the Canadian network for research on vasculitides, whose main objectives are to help conduct studies in the area of vasculitis, provide support and educational materials, and optimize patient care. He has written more than 175 peer-reviewed publications and several textbook chapters on vasculitis.
