

Aslam Anis, PhD, FCAHS, is a Health Economist and Professor in the School of Population and Public Health (SPPH) at the University of British Columbia (UBC). He is also the Director of the Centre for Health Evaluation and Outcome Sciences, National Co-Director of the CIHR Canadian HIV Trials Network and Research Scientist at the Arthritis Research Centre of Canada. Dr. Anis' research activities are extensive and his work has been instrumental in shaping economic policies in Canada, most notably those governing access to anti-retroviral therapy (ART) for persons living with

HIV/AIDS and in pharmaceutical pricing policies. His expertise in health economics also extends to arthritis disease research, particularly cost-effectiveness and productivity evaluations in rheumatoid arthritis patients and to addictions research where he developed research collaborations on the socioeconomic aspects of the treatment and management of individuals with substance abuse problems especially illicit drugs such as opioids and substitution treatment. Dr. Anis has garnered over \$127 million in research grant funding and published over 170 peer-reviewed papers.
