Rules of Play

Dr. Rosie Scuccimarri will chair and be the scorekeeper. Drs. Jennifer Reynolds (west) and Valérie Leclair (east) will be the Team Captains. Dr. Baer will run the program, has composed the questions, and will adjudicate any disputes regarding the correct answers.

- The entire audience answers each question using the meeting app PollEverywhere.
- Rheumatologists, allied health professionals, trainees and industry attendees are all invited to participate
- The room will be divided into 2 teams: East and West, the city of Toronto is the dividing line – Toronto is the WEST, and anything to the east and north of the city centre (including North York, Scarborough, Richmond Hill and Newmarket) is the EAST, as are foreign attendees
- Click PollEverywhere icon in the CRA meeting APP
- Select your team: A= EAST; B = WEST
- Team captains alternate choosing questions
- All questions have 4 multiple choice answers
- There is only 1 correct answer
- Everyone votes with meeting app (PollEverywhere)
- Answer with most votes is the team's official answer
- Both teams can be awarded points for a correct answer
- No deductions for incorrect answers
- Before Final Jeopardy, teams will vote on their wager on the final question: 0, 33, 66 or 100% of their total score
- Highest scoring team wins
