Purpose

To encourage CRA members to develop CME self-assessment/practice reflection programs.

Terms of Reference

1. Open to all members of the CRA
2. The program can be applied in a straightforward and cost-effective manner by CRA members
3. Awardee(s) will have their projects presented at the ASM and/or publicized by the Journal of the Canadian Rheumatology Association (CRAJ)
4. Awardee(s) grants program copyright co-ownership to the CRA
5. Preference will be given to projects involving trainees and/or to projects involving CRA members in private practice

Gold Award	\$1000
Silver Award	\$ 750
Bronze Award	\$ 500

Application Process

Applicants are encouraged to submit their project for a juried review via the following link: [Practice Reflection Award](#). Submission deadline: December 31st.

Adjudication

1. Adjudication is conducted by members of the CRA Education Committee
2. Submissions will be scored on the following criteria:
 - Importance or relevance of the issue that is being addressed
 - Potential of the innovation to address the issue described
 - Ease of program application
 - Cost effectiveness
 - Involvement of trainees
 - Applicability in private practice
 - Scholarly background
3. This is an annual competition, awards are granted on merit and depending upon caliber of submissions, all award(s) may not be granted each year
4. Award(s) will be presented at the following year's Annual Scientific Meeting gala dinner presentation.
